The Path of Great Faith

Small Group Discussion Guide

Based on the message by Pastor Andy Moore, Calvary Temple, March 2, 2025

Conversation Starter:

• If God sent ravens to bring you food like He did for Elijah, what would you hope they'd deliver for breakfast tomorrow morning?

Elijah's Journey of Faith Development

Read I Kings 17:1

- Briefly review Israel's spiritual state during Elijah's time:
 - o 19 consecutive evil kings led Israel away from God
 - Widespread idol worship and child sacrifice
 - King Ahab and Queen Jezebel actively promoting evil

1. Season of Personal Pain (10-12 minutes)

Read 1 Kings 17:2-3 together

Questions for discussion:

- 1. What does the name "Kerith" mean, and why is that significant?
- 2. Pastor Andy said, "God sends us to Kerith so that he can deal with us." Have you experienced a "Kerith" season in your life? What was it like?
- 3. How have painful experiences in your life contributed to spiritual growth?
- 4. Why do we often try to avoid pain, and what blessings might we miss as a result?

2. Season of Total Dependence (10-12 minutes)

Read 1 Kings 17:4-6 together

Questions for discussion:

- 1. How did God provide for Elijah at the brook? What does this teach us about God's character?
- 2. Pastor Andy mentioned, "We want margin, but God gives us what we need when we need it." How have you experienced this in your life?
- 3. What areas of your life are you struggling to fully depend on God?
- 4. Share a story of a time when God provided for you in an unexpected way.

3. Season of Unconditional Obedience (10-12 minutes)

Read 1 Kings 17:7-9 together

Questions for discussion:

- 1. Why did God allow the brook to dry up? What purpose did this serve in Elijah's journey?
- 2. Pastor Andy said, "The place of God's provision became dry." Have you experienced this? What happened next?
- 3. What makes unconditional obedience so difficult? What helps you obey God even when it doesn't make sense?
- 4. How has God used obedience to transform your identity or character?

Application (10-15 minutes)

Read 1 Kings 17:24 together

• Discuss Pastor Andy's central idea: "To do something through us, God must first do something in us."

Questions for discussion:

- 1. What transformation do you see in Elijah from the beginning to the end of this chapter?
- 2. Which of these three seasons (pain, dependence, obedience) are you currently experiencing?
- 3. What is one specific way you can grow in faith this week based on what we've discussed?
- 4. How might our small group support each other through these different seasons?

Closing (5 minutes)

- Summarize key insights from the discussion
- Ask if anyone has prayer requests related to their faith journey
- Close in prayer, asking God to help each person become someone of great faith

Additional Notes for Group Leaders

- Be sensitive to those who may be in a painful "Kerith" season right now
- Encourage vulnerable sharing but don't force it
- Consider breaking into pairs for prayer at the end
- Follow up individually with anyone who seems particularly impacted by the discussion
